In exercise of power conferred under section-5(6) of the O.E. Act, 1969 as amended upto 1994, the High Power Committee constituted under section-5(5) of the O.E. Act, vide Govt. Notification No. 27472/HE., dt. 29.9.2018 after careful consideration in the meeting held on 26.5.2018 have been pleased to grant permission to the college(s) named hereunder as per the details mentioned against each and the conditions as mentioned below.

Financial Conditions for opening of New Colleges.

The Educational Agency sponsoring general college in K.B.K., Scheduled areas/ other areas shall pledge an amount of Rs. 2.5 lakh/Rs. 5.00 lakh in favour of the Prescribed Authority, i.e., the Regional Director of Education, Sambalpur and show Rs. 10.00 lakh/Rs. 20.00 lakh as the case may be in shape of Bank deposit before the Prescribed Authority within a period of one month from the date of grant of permission, failing which the Educational agency shall not be permitted to admit the students. The Educational Agency sponsoring Self-financing Junior College in K.B.K., Scheduled areas/ other areas shall pledge an amount of Rs.10.00 lakh/Rs. 20.00 lakh in favour of the Prescribed Authority for a period of 10 years and show Rs. 4 lakh/Rs. 8.00 lakh in shape of Bank deposit in current account before the Prescribed Authority. Similarly, the Educational Agency sponsoring Selffinancing Degree College in K.B.K., Scheduled areas/ other areas shall pledge an amount of Rs.15.00 lakh/Rs. 30.00 lakh in favour of the Prescribed Authority for a period of 10 years and show Rs. 7.5 lakh/Rs. 15.00 lakh in shape of Bank deposit in current account before the Prescribed Authority, except the Sanskrit College. For Self-financing Sanskrit Degree (Shastri) College, the Educational Agency shall pledge an amount of Rs.7.5 lakh/Rs. 15.00 lakh in favour of the Prescribed Authority for a period of 10 years and show Rs. 2.5 lakh/Rs. 5.00 lakh in shape of Bank deposit in current account before the Prescribed Authority for opening in K.B.K., Scheduled areas/ other areas. The pledging money shall be paid in 02 instalements not exceeding a gap of 06 months and 50% of the amount shall be given in first instalement before grant of permission for opening of college.

2. All +2 Colleges and Plus two wing in Degree Colleges shall be separated and named as Higher Secondary School.

3. The Secretary of the Governing Body must furnish an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit that they will never claim any financial assistance or grant-in-aid from Govt. in future.

4. The Professional Colleges and the General Colleges shall contribute a non-refundable fee of Rs. 2.00 lakhs and 1.00 lakh respectively towards loan stipend fund of the State Government at the time of granting opening permission. This will enable the State Government to take care of the educational needs of poor and meritorious students by providing loan.

The Self-financing Degree Colleges shall fulfil all the conditions laid down in the guideline of the Government in Department of Higher Education, Odisha issued vide letter No. 8730(3)/HE., Dtd. 22.4.2015.

## Condition for opening of New Streams/Subjects/Honours Subject/Increase of seats.

Teachers with M. Phil and or Ph. D. qualification for opening Hons. Subjects.

Bank deposit of Rs. 10.00 lakhs for K.B.K. and scheduled areas, Rs. 20.00 lakhs for other areas for opening of Science stream and Rs. 10.00/5.00 lakhs for opening of new stream in Arts/Commerce in other areas/ Scheduled areas shall be made respectively.

The college management should give an undertaking in the form of an affidavit that any new teacher/non-teaching staff required for teaching/managing the students on account of the above permission shall be funded out of self-financing route. The honorarium/remuneration of these teachers/staff should be at par with other teachers in the college.

Any additional post arising out of increase of seats in the respective subjects shall not be claimed.

The Educational Agency should provide adequate laboratory facility for I.T. and Computer Science. The qualification of I.T. and Computer Science Lecturers shall be M.C.A. or B.E. in I.T. or B.E. in Computer Science.

The above permission is subject to fulfillment of the following terms & conditions.

The State Govt. shall not bear any financial liability at any point of time nor the Governing Body or Educational Agency shall claim grant- in - aid from the State Govt.

Requisite land of Ac. 5.00 acres in case of the Colleges situated in a rural area Ac. 2.00 acres in case of urban area is to be registered in the name of the college with in first two years failing which

recognition shall not be granted to the college. Fire proof college building with required number of class rooms and administrative rooms, laboratory, Library as prescribed in O.E. Rules, 1991 has to be constructed on its own land. The E.A. shall start the construction of building in the following process (i) by 4th year 25% (ii) by 5th year 50% (iii) by 6<sup>th</sup> year 75% (iv) by 7<sup>th</sup> year 100%.

The Governing Body of the College should be registered under Society Registration Act and proposal in the prescribed proforma be submitted to the concerned R.D.E. for approval.

Security deposit as per University statute should be made by the said Governing Body of the College and should be duly pledged to the Registrar of the concerned University.

Permanent qualified teaching and non-teaching staff should be appointed as per the provisions of the O.E. Act, 1969. Appointment of the staff should be made strictly as per U.G.C. guidelines and yardstick in force.

The salary of the staff shall be remitted to their respective bank accounts and report of such remittance shall be submitted to the Regional Director of Education, Sambalpur every month.

The College should procure adequate Degree/Hons. standard Library Books (both text book and reference books) in each permitted subjects/Hons. Subjects.

In case of opening of +3 Science Stream and opening of Hons. in Science subject the college (s) should provide separate laboratories for holding of practical classes in +2 Science & +3 Science in respect of is permitted subject and the Lab. should be well- equipped.

10. All conditions prescribed under section 6 and 6-A of the O.E. Act, 1969 and Rules made there under should be fulfilled to be eligible to get recognition.

After establishment of the colleges, in case of new college(s) a report should be furnished to the concerned Regional Directorate of Education showing the details namely:

1. Location of the College

2. Number of students actually admitted in each stream & subjects.

Necessary application for recognition under Sec-6(I) of the O.E. Act, 1969 shall be made in duplicate in Form No. II with requisite Treasury Chalan and an affidavit attesting the fact that the information furnished therewith are true and correct to the best of the knowledge of the Deponent and an Undertaking as required Under Section 6 (a) (2) of the O.E. Act, 1969 should be furnished with the (Dr. Pravabati Guru) application.
